

Data Protection Declaration

The entities of the Ammann Group (hereafter, **Ammann**) respect your privacy and personal sphere. Ammann takes the protection of your personal data, such as your name, date of birth, address, email address, telephone number, IP address where applicable, etc., very seriously. This Data Protection Declaration regulates the processing of your personal data. Ammann always handles your data in strict compliance with the relevant statutory data protection regulations and the following principles.

The websites of the Ammann Group entities may contain links to the websites of other providers. This Data Protection Declaration does not apply to such websites of other providers.

1. Definition of Personal Data and Processing

“Personal Data” means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person; an identifiable natural person can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person.

“Processing” means any operation which is performed on personal data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination, or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction.

2. Data Avoidance and Data Minimization

Ammann complies with the principle of data avoidance and data minimization when processing personal data. This means that Ammann processes as little personal data as possible.

3. Collection and Processing of Personal Data and Consent

Ammann stores and processes your personal data where necessary for the establishment, execution, or termination of a contractual or contract-like customer relationship.

Further, Ammann searches on professional platforms for suitable candidates for a vacancy and uses the personal data published there by potential candidates to check whether the person fits in with Ammann and, if necessary, to make contact. This data is deleted after the end of the selection process unless an application process follows. The basis for the search is

Ammann's legitimate interest in filling positions with suitable persons. You have a right of objection.

Ammann will otherwise only process personal data with your prior consent. In this case, your personal data will only be used for the purpose and to the extent stated in the consent. For example, Ammann will only inform you about our products and services after you have consented. You can withdraw your consent at any time with effect in the future. Ammann will delete your data upon receipt of the withdrawal of consent. You can withdraw your consent the same way you have given it, though you may always also send the withdrawal of consent to the following address:

Personal data that you use in the context of general communication with Ammann (e.g., inquiries about products via our online contact forms and outside of any contractual or contract-like customer relationship) will only be processed by Ammann for the purposes of this communication. Here, too, you have the right to the aforementioned withdrawal of consent.

In particular:

Ammann customer magazine

You have the option to subscribe to our customer magazine on our website. The data provided during magazine registration will only be used for the dispatch of the customer magazine unless you agree to use it further. You can cancel the subscription anytime using the unsubscribe option provided in the customer magazine. Your data will be deleted upon termination of the subscription.

Ammann newsletter

You have the option to register for our newsletter on our website. The data provided during registration will only be used for sending the newsletter unless you agree to use it further. Each newsletter contains a link to unsubscribe immediately. Your data will be deleted when you unsubscribe.

Login Data

You may register as a dealer for future communications with Ammann and orders of Ammann products on our Dealer Portal and Dealer Shop websites. The data provided during the registration of a customer account will only be used for direct customer communication unless you agree to use it further. You can delete your account at any time.

4. Links and Hyperlinks

The use of hyperlinks on the websites of Ammann may result in you leaving the network and systems of Ammann. Ammann accepts no responsibility whatsoever for the content, correctness, or operability of these third-party websites. The links are provided in good faith, and Ammann assumes no responsibility for changes to third-party websites we refer to via links. Including a link to other websites does not represent any recommendation by Ammann. We strongly advise you to carefully review the legal and data protection information that applies to the other websites you visit.

5. Google Analytics

This website uses Google Analytics version 4, a web analysis service offered by Google LLC. Google Analytics helps us understand our visitors' behaviors by collecting and analyzing data about website traffic and user interactions. This is technically achieved through the use of "cookies," which are small text files placed on your device, and other technologies. Before any data is collected via Google Analytics, we seek your explicit consent through the privacy popup. Furthermore, IP anonymization is enabled.

7. Mobile Apps

When using the mobile Sales and Service Apps of Ammann, analysis techniques may be used whose scope of application corresponds to that of cookies. Information on the collection and processing of personal data via the mobile Sales and Service Apps of Ammann can be found in the terms and conditions of the corresponding App. Ammann Apps only collect and process your personal data with your consent, which is expressly requested before using the Apps.

8. Social Plugins

The Ammann Group uses so-called social plugins (hereinafter function buttons) of social networks such as Facebook, Twitter, and YouTube.

When visiting our website, these function buttons are deactivated by default, i.e., they do not send any data to the respective social networks unless you specify otherwise. Before using the function buttons, you must activate them with your click. A function button remains active

until you deactivate it again or delete your cookies. Further information about cookies may be found in our [Cookie Notes](#).

After activation, a direct connection is established with the server of the respective social network. The content of the function button is then transferred directly from the social networks to your browser and integrated into the website.

After activating a function button, the respective social network can collect data, regardless of whether you interact with the function button. If you are logged in to a social network, it can assign this visit to your user account. A social network cannot assign a visit to other Ammann websites until you have activated the function button on those websites.

Suppose you are a member of a social network and want to avoid associating the data collected during your visit to our website with your saved membership information. In that case, you must log out of that social network before activating the function buttons.

We have no influence on the amount of data collected by the social networks with their buttons. The respective social network is solely responsible for any processing of personal data that starts with you clicking on the link. The purpose and scope of the data collection and the further processing and use of the data by the respective social networks as well as your relevant rights and setting options for protecting your privacy can be found in the data protection notices of the respective social networks.

9. Third-party Access to your Personal Data

Ammann itself carries out the collection, processing, and use of personal data and – unless Ammann has expressly excluded this – also by service providers commissioned by Ammann. In the latter case, Ammann will ensure that the service providers comply with the relevant data protection regulations and the obligations arising from this Data Protection Declaration. Service providers may be hired, for example, for the dispatch of goods or advertising materials or the organization of price competitions.

Further, Ammann will process data, in particular transfer data to official state authorities, in response to official or legal requirements and, in the case of legal duties, to notify.

Otherwise, no third party has access to your personal data. In particular, Ammann will not sell or otherwise exploit such data.

10. Data Security

Ammann uses appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data managed by us against loss, alteration, destruction, misappropriation, or access by

unauthorized persons. These security measures are continuously improved in line with technological developments.

All Ammann websites are SSL certified.

11. Children

Ammann is not interested in a targeted collection of personal data of children under the age of 16. Should Ammann become aware that such data has been transmitted without the consent of a parent or legal guardian, Ammann will delete it immediately. Ammann is dependent on appropriate information from you as parents or guardians.

12. Right of Access and Right of Rectification

Upon request, Ammann will inform you as quickly as possible in writing and in accordance with applicable law whether and which personal data about you is stored by us. If we have stored incorrect information despite our efforts to ensure the data is correct and up-to-date, we will rectify this immediately at your request.

13. Right to Delete, Limit Processing, Transfer Data, and File Complaints

Ammann will delete your personal data if the business purpose associated with the data has ceased to exist or if the relevant data protection regulations so require. In the event of consent, Ammann will delete your data after the withdrawal of consent or loss of purpose for consent.

At your express request, Ammann will restrict or fully block personal data. To do this, you inform Ammann to what extent and for how long the restriction or block is to take place. As far as technically possible, you can thus exclude the processing and use of your data for specific areas. Furthermore, your personal data will be blocked if this is provided for in the relevant data protection regulations. At your express request and if applicable to your personal data, Ammann will set your personal data in a structured and machine-readable format and can transfer them directly from one company to another within the Ammann Group or to any third party, as far as technically feasible.

You may also assert your rights against the competent supervisory authority at any time.

14. Amendments to this Data Protection Declaration

Ammann always keeps this Data Protection Declaration up to date. It may therefore be necessary to adapt the Data Protection Declaration to changes in actual or legal conditions. The currently valid version is always the version published on the Ammann website.
